There are, of course, many strategic business frameworks for business planning. However, we like to call the Business Model Canvas "a business plan on a page". It is a fantastic tool which enables you to rapidly develop business plans and consider all the elements required to make your business a success. You can quickly identify broken links in your business strategy and refine accordingly.

The Business Model Canvas (BMC) can be used by solopreneurs, start-ups, established companies and large corporates. Start-ups can use the BMC to plan their **future** product development, resources and market entry strategies. Many existing businesses use the BMC to better understand how their company **currently** creates and delivers value for their customers. However, in between those two things is **ideation**. In other words, if you know where you are today and you're looking for ways to create business models for tomorrow, you must ideate. The BMC can be a really powerful tool to get the creative (ideation) juices flowing.
